- reformer (noun) a person who wants to make changes to something
- First Confiscation Act It was passed on August 6, 1861 and allowed the Union army to take over Confederate property and free enslaved people from having to work for the Confederate military.
- Emancipation Proclamation issued by President Abraham Lincoln, it declared that all slaves in the Confederate states were free and allowed Black men to enlist in military service
- veteran (noun) a person who fought in war
- **pension** (noun) a monthly payment
